

#### What is ProTools?

- Ancestry add-on service consisting of a number of tools
- Cost: \$10/month
  - In the past month, two short-lived incentives (\$30/6 months, free days)
- **Requires** a paid Ancestry subscription (e.g., US, World, etc.)

# Components of ProTools

- A bit difficult to find all of them in Ancestry
- Some are on top menus, some seem to be a bit buried
- This is what pops up with a search for "Pro Tools" in Help
- I'll try my best to document the most useful in the Trees and in the DNA sections





# ProTools – Tree Checker

- Similar to what exists in family tree software programs (e.g., Family Tree Maker, RootsMagic, etc.)
- Examples:
  - Catching duplicates
  - People with no sources
  - Impossible parentage
- Can take many hours to all these

# ProTools – Tree Mapper

- Hard to find
- Open a tree that you own and have set the home person for
- Click on the tree orientation button on the left and select "Tree Mapper"




#### ProTools – Tree Mapper

- Clunky (in my own opinion)
- Open a tree that you own and have set the home person for
- When I try to look at my paternal line (50% Portuguese/Azores, 37% Irish, 13% early colonial/English): nothing shown for Portuguese or Irish
- Maybe you had better experience with it

#### Filtering

To access and use smart filters, you need an active Ancestry® Pro Tools Membership.

#### 1. Above the list of all people, click More filters.

- 2. In the panel on the right, select or deselect a filter (or multiple filters).
- · Family line: Filter by direct line ancestors (people you descend from), paternal (father's) line, maternal (mother's) line, end of line, or people without relationships. • Events & places: Filter by birth, marriage, death, burial, lived in, or any event. Select one, "Any Event" (to search all), or none to search without events.
- If choosing an event or place:
- Enter a year or date range
- For an exact year, click "Exact year."
- · For a specific date range, click "Add range.
- · Provide location details if known or wanted.
- To remove an event or place, click the X.
- · Possible Errors: Filter by "Possible duplicates," "People with no sources," "People with only tree sources," and "Other possible errors.
- · Hints: Include only people with Ancestry Hints®.




# Components of ProTools -- DNA

- Okay, this is the BIG one --- Enhanced Shared Matches
- We are now able to see how much DNA our matches share with other matches
  - This is similar to what is on MyHeritage and 23andMe
- IMHO --- This is alone worth paying for ProTools



- Click on Shared Matches
- Now you can see how much 2 of your DNA matches share with each other
- Find out if there is a parentchild relationship or other close relationship



- Access by opening your list of DNA matches
- Select a match
- In this example, using my mother's DNA kit I choose a match that I believe is the closest on her mystery maternal grandfather's side (an NPE)
- 178 cMs, presumably a 2<sup>nd</sup> cousin once removed (most likely after analyzing in "What Are The Odds" tool)
- NOTE: Tree is private and no common ancestors hints shown




- I opened up the shared matches for this strong match and then clicked through some of them to get the matching DNA amounts
- Note this match (we'll call him GL) has only 8 shared matches and 4 of those are very close family so not useful for analysis
- And, those 4 shared matches are fairly distant (25, 31, 20, and 23 cMs)




- HOWEVER---when I click on those other 4 matches I get a much larger pool of matches
- Clicking on the first one, DD, yields 30 shares
- This allows me to begin to construct a hypothetical relationship chart, especially using close relationships
- Also, some of these new shares will have family trees that I can gather surnames from



- Thinking graphically...
- I start with Mom's DNA and GL's and add the 4 shared matches for GL with the DNA amounts available without this tool (blue lines)
- With enhanced shared matches I now have the DNA amounts shown as green lines here




- Now, looking at DD's shares I find many more, 30, that are not shared with GL but are shared to Mom
- One, at 371 cMs has a tree with surnames that I know are in GL's tree that I constructed



# Using Enhanced Shared Matches to Construct DNA Relationship Diagrams


More Tree work and Shared DNA match data need to be analyzed to either prove or refute this hypothesis



- One unexpected benefit that I found:
  - You can now get shared matches < 20 cMs that show up



Great example of the usefulness of the new Ancestry share tool for subscribers who also subscribe to ProTools. These are shared matches to a 40 cM match to my deceased uncle Ernie. I am looking to determine if this match is on Ernie's paternal grandfather side or his paternal grandmother side. Look what was lurking below the 20 cMs level that I never knew to be shared matches since they were all < 20. All with trees (haven't checked, maybe several of them are the same tree). It will be some work to figure all this out but, wow, what a wealth of information (6 very close relatives) so that it should be a breeze to work out a good tree for this match. Time for a Quick & Dirty tree followed by a LucidChart DNA diagram, wouldn't you say??
